

## Wind Energy Asia 2021 will showcase great localization results

Integrating a truly hybrid real exhibition with a virtual platform to breach time and space in this pandemic world

Wind Energy Asia, the largest and most international wind expo in Taiwan and second largest in Asia, despite the pandemic can be held live in the Kaohsiung Exhibition Center from March 10 to 12, 2021. This year, again with the strong support of the Ministry of Economic Affairs, the Ocean Commission, and the Kaohsiung City Government, a total of more than 100 industry players from 12 countries are participating in the exhibition. Among them, Denmark, the Netherlands, Germany, Sweden have country pavilions. In addition, our innovative online to offline platform allows exhibitors to have their physical booths in the venue and an O2O virtual one on our platform. And visitors can come in person if in Taiwan, or virtually from anywhere in the world. This will allow foreigners to avoid travel restrictions, bringing more buyers and business opportunities.

The organizer specially invited GCWA and the NCKU team this year to present a high-level topic coming to Taiwan and offshore in general: "floating wind". This is poised to be a key feature in future. And we have the model in the venue for you to see on-site.

In order to help with the localization in the wind industry, WEA 2021 will also hold a forum on March 11 to discuss the current development and future prospects of the wind energy industry. Domestic and foreign industry leaders and scholars have been invited to the podium. Key opinions come from the Bureau of Energy, Industrial Development Bureau, Taiwan Construction Research Institute, Taiwan Wind Industry Association, Awareocean Technology, GCWA, CIP, RWE and Siemens Gamesa are on the program. Some of the topics are the latest on Phase 3 tenders, localization, wind technology, education and training, finance, floating wind, marine environment and operation and management. On Friday, March 12 we hold our Job Fair to allow professionals and students interested in wind energy careers to learn and evaluate employment opportunities. Companies might find suitable candidates here and help expand the talent base in Taiwan on the road to becoming an important base for the industry in Asia!

Regarding the coronavirus outbreak, we strongly recommend every participant to wear a face mask, temperature will be measured before going into venue building and again before going into the hall, alcohol disinfectant sprays will be sprayed on hands at all entrances. We will keep the doors in the hall open and the fans going to ensure good air circulation. The stage area, elevators, toilets and other public area in the venue are disinfected frequently. We will be paying high attention to any related news released by the government and inform all exhibitors and guests immediately of any major developments, but we feel safe with the measures the health authorities have taken, which is reflected in the low number of cases in Taiwan and basically the lack of community spread.




